

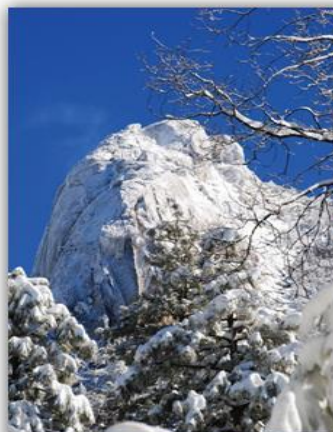

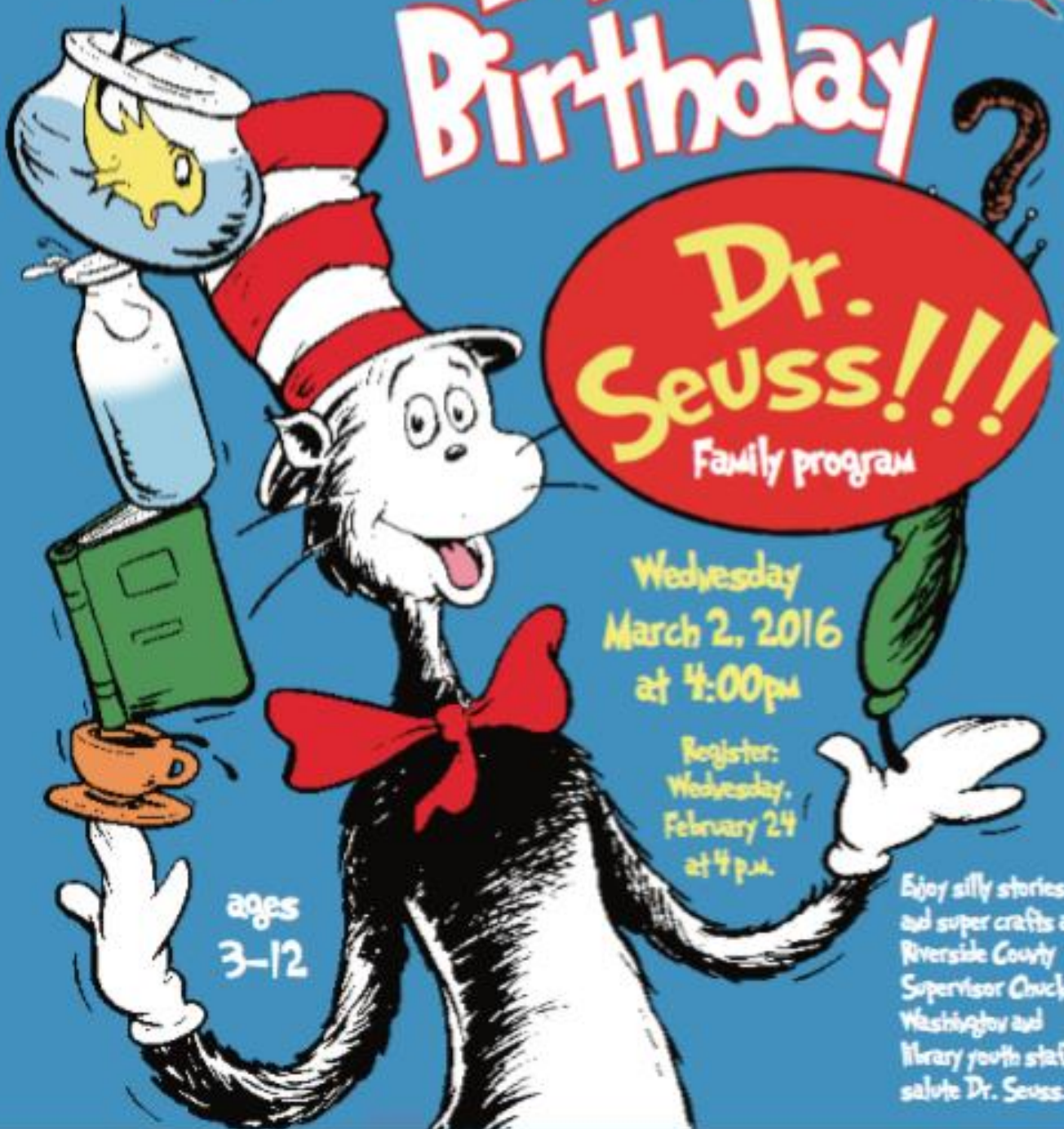
Supervisor Washington and the youth staff of the Temecula Library will be reading some of Dr. Seuss's classical stories. Dr. Seuss is the pen name for Theodor Seuss Geisel, the author and illustrator of more than 60 popular children's books including "The Cat in the Hat," "Horton Hears a Hoo," "Green Eggs and Ham," and the Christmas favorite, "How the Grinch Stole Christmas."

Each year on the author's birthday, the National Education Association's hosts "Read Across America" which encourages the nation to bring Dr. Seuss stories to life at libraries, schools and community center on Dr. Seuss's Birthday . Now in its 18th year, this program which runs year-round focuses on motivating children and teens to read through events, partnerships, and reading resources.

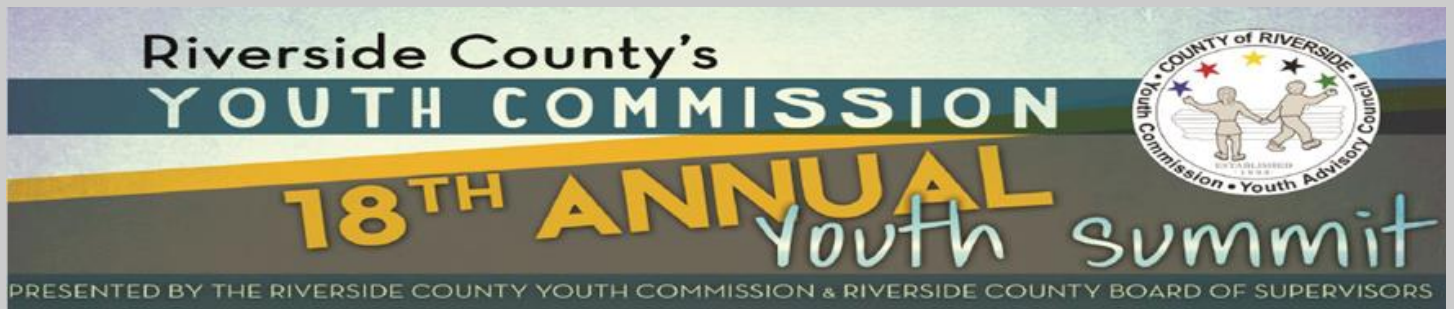

Riverside County's 18th Annual Youth Summit will take place at Pechanga Resort and Conference Center on Thursday, March 24th. This event is presented by the Riverside County Youth Commission and the Riverside County Board of Supervisors. Every year the Summit is held in different Supervisorial districts, with this year's summit being held in the 3rd District. The event is free for every school that attends. The students and chaperones receive breakfast, lunch, giveaways, and transportation costs are reimbursed to the schools.

Riverside County Supervisor Chuck Washington will open the event.

The Youth Summit will offer a variety of workshops that will include A.L.I.C.E. Intruder Safety Training, Substance Abuse Awareness and Education, Mental Health Awareness, and Youth Empowerment.

"The ultimate goal of the Youth Summit is to discuss these issues, provide a solution, and improve the present and future lives of youth living in Riverside County," stated Washington.

School administrators, public leaders, and safety officers are invited to attend the 18th Annual Youth Summit for a workshop presented by A.L.I.C.E. (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuation). A.L.I.C.E. is a program that teaches students and adults how to respond in an active shooter event on their campus or other public space. Through the combined use of video, scenario role-play and informative dialogue, students will leave this workshop with information that could save lives should they ever experience such an event.

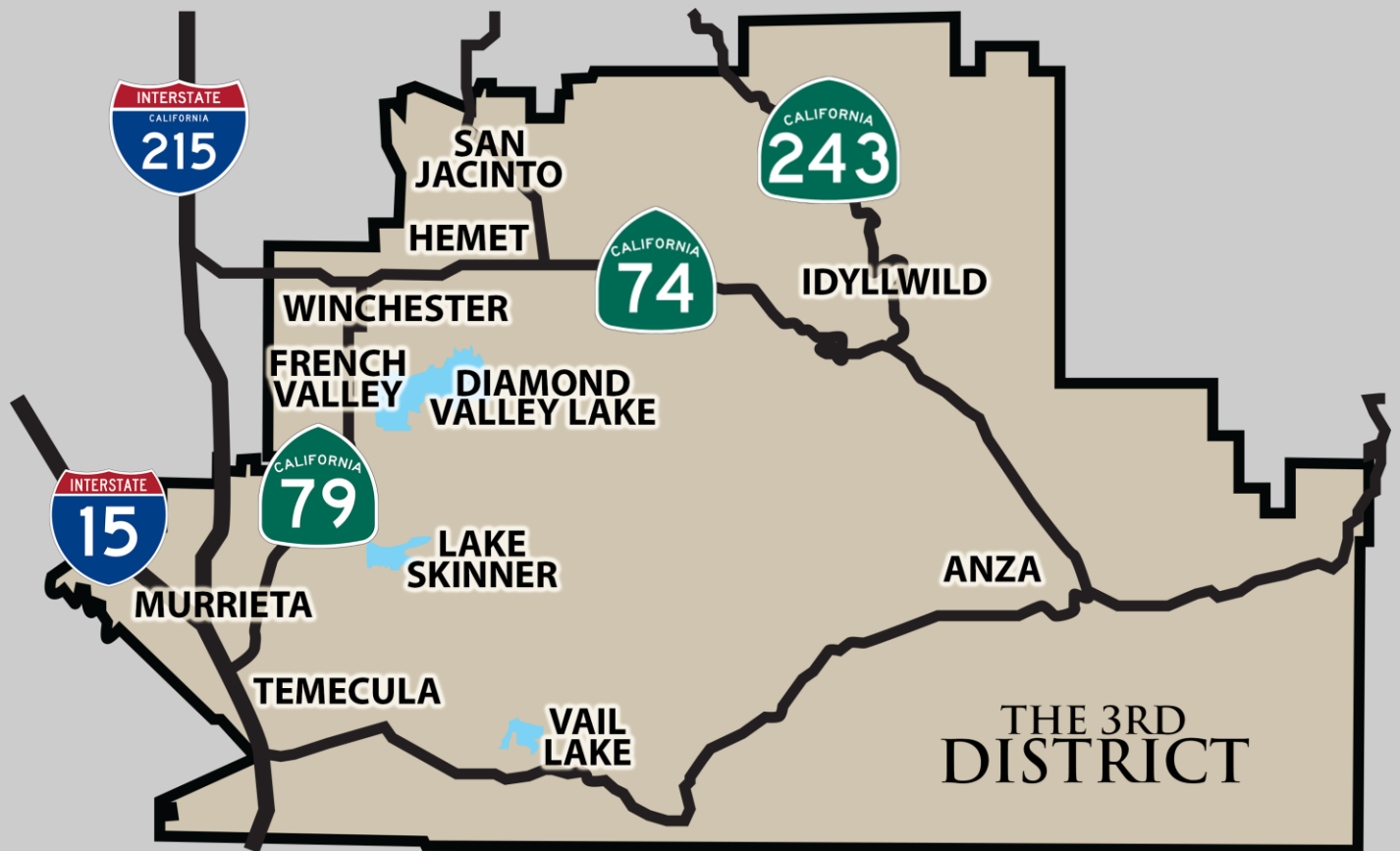
