June 29, 2010, Item 3.7, Resolution 2010-183, Creating the Winchester Municipal Advisory Council in accordance with Government Code Section 31010 and County Board Policy A-51.

March 12, 2013 – 3-67: Resolution 2013-060, Dissolving the Romoland-Homeland MAC; Resolution No. 2013-061, Amending the Winchester MAC and Renaming it the Winchester/Homeland MAC; Resolution No. 2013-063, Amending the Lakeview/Nuevo MAC and renaming it the Nuview/Romoland MAC

Resolution No. 2010-183 previously adopted on June 29, 2010, is hereby rescinded and replaced by this Resolution No. 2013-061. The amended Winchester/Homeland MAC shall adhere to the provisions of Government Code Section 21010 and County Board Policy A-51.

***The 2010 Census established new boundaries for the County Board of Supervisors. The citizens in the affected communities desire to amend the boundaries of the Municipal Advisory Councils to be consistent with Supervisorial Districts. It is necessary to dissolve the Romoland-Homeland MAC due to overlapping boundaries with the City of Menifee and the newly established boundaries of the Third and Fifth Supervisorial Districts. The remaining unincorporated areas previously within the Romoland-Homeland MAC territory will be included in the existing Lakeview/Nuevo MAC and the Winchester MAC which will be renamed to recognize the additions of the Romoland and Homeland areas. ***

Purpose:

To serve as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors and to advise on matters including but not limited to public health, public works, welfare, safety, and planning in said territory.

Direct County Funding (and source):

Funding as required to carry out the business and functions of the MAC shall be determined, provided for, managed, and appropriated within the annual operating budget of the Supervisor's district for which the MAC is formed.

MEMBER CRITERIA

Qualifications for Appointment:

All Appointees and/or elected members must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and shall be a resident within the boundaries of the said territory.

Membership:

Shall consist of five (5) regular members and two (2) alternate members, each of who shall be appointed by and serve at large at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

Tenure/Term of Office:

Two (2) Years from May 1 of the year appointed to April 30 two (2) years hence. (Initial appointments shall have staggered terms.)

Vacancies:

Vacancies occurring due to death, resignation, or a member moving out of the council territory shall be filled by an appointment made by the Supervisor of the District. Persons appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

Officers:

The Advisory Council shall choose from among its members a presiding officer, an assistant presiding officer and a secretary. This shall be done at the first meeting after the appointment of the Advisory Council and every year thereafter.

Meetings:

The Advisory Council shall determine the number of its regular meetings, which shall be at least quarterly, and shall by standing order, fix the time and place of its meetings, which shall be within the County of Riverside and, normally, within the boundaries of the CC/MAC. (A quorum shall consist of majority of the members of the Advisory Council not counting vacant positions.)

Compensation:

All members shall serve without compensation.
